
ARTS/COMMERCE FACULTY REPORT

These words of Svetlana Alexievich, Nobel Laureate in Literature 2015 strike the keynote of the spirit and essence of the moment - the close of the year 2015. Very much like at the close of an event or at the close of a journey, at the close of 2015 too the human mind and soul instinctively reverts, looks back on the path traversed, and experiences a gamut of thoughts and emotions. Undoubtedly, the close of 2015 brings in its wake reflection and retrospection; it spells re-visiting one's endeavours and motives; it inspires re-evaluation of one's potential and aims, and it compels reconsideration of one's plans and strategies. The close of 2015 and the beginning of 2016 thus marks revival, rejuvenation and reconnection of a human being with his/her 'self, that human being that Svetlana, the Noble Laureate so aptly believed in and emphasized upon, and that, who, with his/her thoughts, feelings and deeds sends ripples (negative or positive, constructive or destructive... is a matter of personal choice) across the neighbourhood, society, nation, and world at large.
