KUBERAKSHI-THE FEVER NUT

Kuberakshi, scientifically known as *Caesalpinia bonduc L.* which belongs to Family Fabaceae (Caesalpiniodeae) is a rare medicinal plant. It is going to be endangered. It is a vine like perennial and evergreen shrub found in Bhojpur block in Modinagar. The whole plant is useful as medicine e.g. root, stem, leaves, fruit and seeds. The plant contains many antibacterial, antiviral, and antifungal constituents viz. bonducellpin E(5), caesalpina A(6), stearic acid, octadeca-4, ligoceric, linolenic, oleic acid, citrulline, aspartic acid, etc. It is an effective herb to cure the present outbreaks of chikungunya, dengue, malaria and viral fever. It acts against the larvae of Ades mosquito parasite plasmodium which break down the human health and causes muscular pain, headache, nausea, fatigue, joint pain etc. All these diseases can be controlled by using seed kernel which is called poor quinine. The powder of kernel is mixed with black pepper in equal parts and given three times in a day. Dosage - 15-20 grains for adults and 3-4 grains for children. Its other parts are also useful in small pox, elephantiasis, liver disease, piles, aphrodisiac, in urinary problems, intestinal worms, asthma etc. The plant can be grown on the waste land or as fencing hedge.
