## NATIONAL SEMINAR 28TH FEBRUARY, 2017

### "NATIONAL INTEGRATION AND EMPOWERMENT THROUGH PHYSICAL EDUCATION & SPORTS"

## PHYSICS DEPARTMENT REPORT

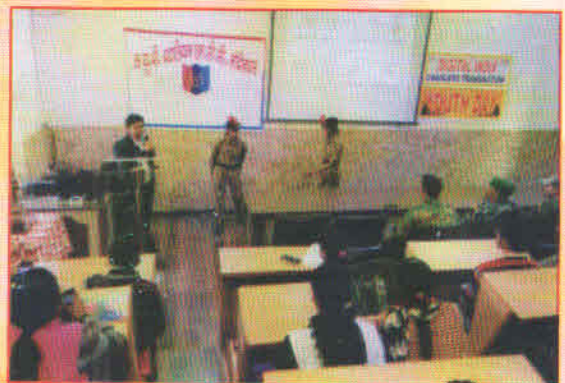

### THE BILVA TREE- BELPATRA
