HEALTH CORNER

INDIAN GOOSEBERRY (Scientific Name - Phyllanthus Emblica)

Other Name(s): Aamalaki, Amalaki, Amblabaum, Amla, Amla Berry, Aonla, Aovla, Arbre de Malacca.

Because of its fibre and water content and it's great anti inflummatroy properties, it help soothes the intestinal lining and thus curb acidity.

We might be consuming enough calcium through our diet but the amount of calcium absorbed through the food ingested depends upon various factors. Amla helps in better absorption of calcium in the body.

Because of its diuretic property, it helps in the elimination of various toxins and unwanted excess salt through urine.
