Dr K. N. Modi University (DKNMU) and Multanimal Modi College, Modinagar recognizing the benefits to their respective institutions from the establishment of conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

The Memorandum of Understanding is to take effect from 15 July, 2021

1. The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and educational cooperation, mutual understanding between the two academic institutions.
2. This MoU signifies a statement of intent to collaborate, but is *not* a legally binding document.



3. Two academic institutions agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic area of mutual interest on basis of equality and reciprocity
  - 3.1. Exchange of faculty and administrative staff.
  - 3.2. Exchange of students.
  - 3.3. Conducting collaborative research in fields of mutual interest.
  - 3.4. Promoting other academic co-operation as mutually agreed.
  - 3.5. Organizing seminar, symposia, lectures, conferences within the objectives of each institution.
4. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between faculties, schools or institutes which carry out the specific projects using instruments available in Central Instrumental Facility (CIF).
5. Both institutions agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective states after full consultation and approval.
6. Multanimal Modi College, Modinagar and Dr. K. N. Modi University, Newai recognize the value of this MoU to each other in promoting their programmes and activities, but any promotional material/activity which includes reference to concerned states must be sent to and be approved by the respective institutions or any other person authorized by both the institutions before use and print. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the institutions concerned.
7. Both institutions should undertake collaborative research activities under the MoU result in any potential for intellectual property, both institutions shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.
8. This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutions.
9. In any case of discontinuance, the parties will honor agreed commitments either via the accepted arrangement or suitable alternative negotiated at that point.
10. The institutions will make suitable arrangements for the exchange of visiting scholars, faculty, staff and doctoral fellows.

11. The institutions will seek opportunities to cooperation in a variety of academic/research areas.
12. The institutions will exchange scholarly information including research papers, indices to theses, books and magazines on relevant subjects where possible and appropriate.
13. The institutions will extend invitations for attending scholarly and technical meetings/lectures and assist in making arrangements for attending national and international conferences.
14. Arrangements concerning specific details of financial support will be made by written agreement applicable to each particular situations and legal terms and condition.
15. The names, crests and logos of the institutions are the intellectual property of those institutions and may not be used without the express written permission of the institutions that owns a particular name crest or logo.

The MoU will be for 5 (Five) years from the date 15<sup>th</sup> July 2021, and will be reviewed thereafter. Each party has the right to discontinue the arrangement subject to a period of 6 months' notice in advance. The Understanding may also be terminated at any time by mutual consent of both the parties. However, such termination shall not affect participating student/researcher to complete the semester/work in which he or she is then enrolled/working under this MoU.
