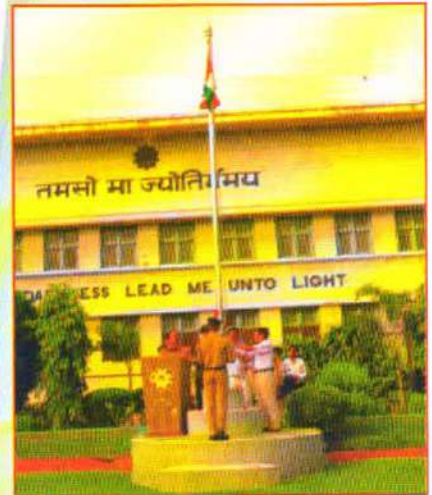
## INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS


